COSTUME SUGGESTIONS:

Chorus Members and Tone Chime Choir– please wear dark pants or skirt (girls) and a white top .

Any other costume for your classroom performance can be slipped right over this basic layer.

These performing groups (including band) go on first. They will have time to return to classroom and slip on the costume they need to wear for the classroom performance and put on a little makeup if required.

Pre-Kindergarten- Holiday themed or colored party clothes

Ring Those Bells...Traditional



Kindergarten – “Santa” outfit. Red t shirt or sweatshirt/sweater. Santa hat

Must Be Santa...Moore/Fredericks

Grade 1- Any variety of holiday characters: Santa, Elf, Reindeer – either costumes or holiday dress up clothes with Christmas novelty hats. (Elf hat, Santa hat, reindeer antlers, etc)

Getting' Ready for Santa Claus...Albrecht/Althouse

Grade 2 – Reindeer outfit- any outfit that suggests a reindeer...suggestion: brown, white, shirt/sweatshirt, paint on a little reindeer nose, some freckles.

Students will wear reindeer antlers.

Eight Little Tails...Redmond/Cavanaugh/Weldon

Grade 3 – Outfit that resembles a snowman. Suggestion: all white pants and shirt/sweatshirt with red or black circles down the front (pinned on) and a black top hat or cap with a colorful scarf around neck.

Frosty the Snowman...Rollins/Nelson

Grade 4 – an outfit to resemble a candy cane; Suggestions: red and white colors; striped socks or tights, candy cane hat or striped Santa hat. All solid items can be “striped” with white painters tape.

Candy Cane Twist...Beck/Fisher

Grade 5 –“Caribbean” theme. Straw hats or bandana for head. “Vacation wear” tropical theme

Conga Bells for Recorder...Norm Sands

Grade 6 – All BOYS are shepherds; All GIRLS are angels.

Grade 7- Pajamas, preferably Christmas color or theme.
